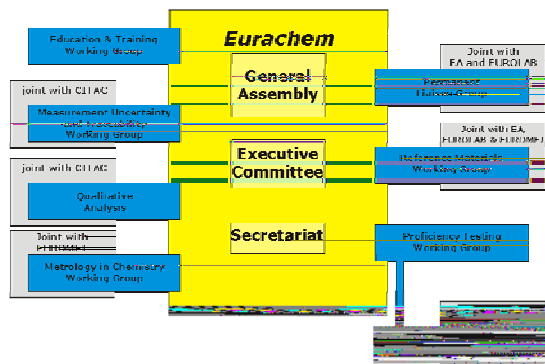

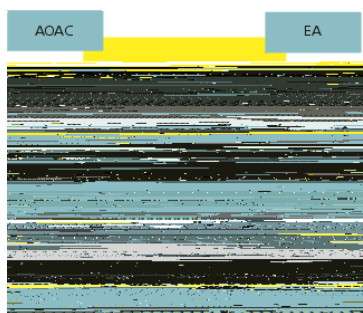
Eurachem – a little background
