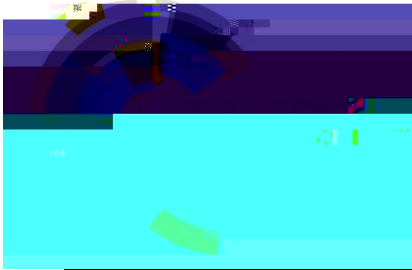
The committee also awards bursaries on behalf of the IOP for young researchers whose work falls within carbon science in the opinion of the IOP.

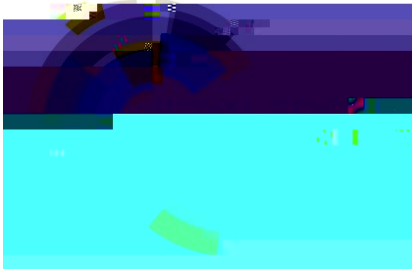

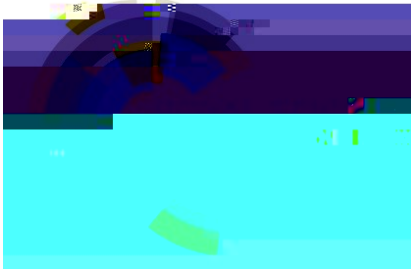
